

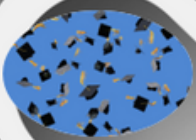

As you may know Broadoak is 100 years old this year! To celebrate this and the success of our awesome #simplythebest Year 11 students we would like to share the TOP TEN success stories from the results this year so far...

<p>Our current percentage for GCSE Grade 9-4 is 10% higher than it was this time last year!</p>	<p>When asked about the out of timetable sessions they have had since the PPEs (reteach lessons) 85/109 students said they Agree or Strongly Agree that they were helpful</p>	<p>5 students achieved a Grade 9 in English Language during this first round of PPEs! Wow!</p>	<p>Our current percentage for GCSE Grade 9-5 is 6% higher than it was this time last year!</p>
<p>50 students out of 164 have ALREADY achieved Grade 4 or better in BOTH English and Maths – awesome!</p>	<p>62% of students have already attained their Grade 4 in maths (that's 102 students out of 164)!
