



Year 11 students are expected to attend at least 2 period 7 sessions per week between November and March; this will increase to 3 sessions after PPE 2 (March – GCSE Exams)



Y11 TOP TEN









As you may know Broadoak is 100 years old this year! To celebrate this and the success of our awesome #simplythebest Year 11 students we would like to share the TOP TEN success stories from the results this year so far...

Our current percentage for GCSE Grade 9-4 is 10% higher than it was this time last year!

When asked about the out of timetable sessions they have had since the PPEs (reteach lessons) 85/109 students said they Agree or Strongly Agree that they were helpful

5 students achieved a Grade 9 in English Language during this first round of PPEs! Wow! Our current percentage for GCSE Grade 9-5 is 6% higher than it was this time last year!

50 students out of 164 have ALREADY achieved Grade 4 or better in BOTH English and Maths – awesome! 62% of students have already attained their Grade 4 in maths (that's 102 students out of 164)! Woohoo! When asked whether they revised and prepared for these assessments 85/109 students said they did – the work they have put it is clear in the results

When asked whether they knew what the PPEs were focussed on (prep by the teacher in advance) 98 / 109 said they did

From the 6th of December to 1st May are 100 school days – please ask your child about their 100 day plan
