# Home – Academy Agreement 2023 – 2024

This document outlines the principles between the Academy, its students and parents/carers.

This partnership agreement is intended to reinforce the student's positive experience at Broadoak Academy.

## **As a student I will:**

- Attend Academy regularly and on time between 8.30-8.40am. All gates are closed at 8.42am except for the Devonshire Road gate, this will remain open until 9.05am. Any students arriving after this time will have to enter via reception.
- Be polite and respect the rights and well-being of others, even if not on the Academy premises.
- Wear the Academy uniform and be tidy in appearance at all times between leaving and returning to the family home.
- All students need to bring a bag every day to carry the required equipment.
- Do all classwork and homework set.
- Take good care of equipment and the building.
- Seek at all times to make a positive contribution to the life and development of Broadoak.
- Follow the 4 Academy rules below.

## ***Calm, Consistent, Caring***

Work hard and allow others to learn	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Arrive to lessons on time</li><li>• Remain on task</li><li>• Focus on your learning</li><li>• Persevere when work is challenging</li></ul>
Follow staff instructions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Listen to instructions, without interruption</li><li>• Do as you are told, without arguing</li></ul>
Speak / act politely and with respect to everyone	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Speak calmly and with an appropriate tone of voice, without shouting</li><li>• Not use swear words or words that might offend (e.g. racist or homophobic words)</li></ul>
Respect the Academy and its environment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Follow the rules of the Academy</li><li>• Be a positive ambassador for the Academy community</li><li>• Look after the Academy resources</li><li>• Keep the Academy calm, safe and tidy</li></ul>

## As a parent / carer I will:

- Start from a position of trust, working in partnership with the Academy to help my child achieve maximum potential.
- Let the Academy know about any matters that might affect my child's work or behaviour by emailing [parents@broadoakacademy.clf.uk](mailto:parents@broadoakacademy.clf.uk) or calling 01934 422000.
- Support my child in completing homework via Show My Homework at <https://www.satchelone.com> or via the app with your parent account.
- Make sure my child arrives on time between 8.30 – 8.42am.
- Make sure my child brings the right equipment – pencil case, black biro, red biro, pencil, ruler, rubber and school bag.
- Report, on a daily basis, any absences from school by calling 01934 422000 or emailing [parents@broadoakacademy.clf.uk](mailto:parents@broadoakacademy.clf.uk) by 9am each morning.
- Make sure my child wears the Academy uniform to the highest standards, including all the way to school and all the way home again.
- Attend Parents' Evenings and Parent Information Evenings.
- Support the respectful ethos of the Academy by setting a good example in my behaviour towards all members of the school community, in both verbal and written form.
- Support the implementation of the Academy rules by reminding your child of our rules and expectations.
