



Y11 Curriculum Overview

Core Subjects:


- All students in Y11 study all core subjects and are allocated 5 periods of each a week:
 - English Literature
 - English Language
 - Maths (opportunity for additional GCSE in Further Maths in Y11)
 - Science (Combined or Separate*) students who study separate science are allocated 9 periods as they are studying towards 3 separate science GCSE grades.

Option Subjects:

Alongside their core subjects, students in Y10 also study 4 'options' based on their preferences chosen in Y9.

These options are divided into 4 blocks A-D and are allocated 3 periods a week. This is usually a double and a single lesson.

P7 is an additional lesson designed to support students further with their core/option subjects



How we are supporting our KS4 students...



Morning tutorials - bespoke KS4 tutorial programme focused on Reading, Revision & Exam Strategies, Wellbeing & Resilience. Opportunities during tutor time for additional tuition in Maths, English and Science.



PSHE lessons – focused on statutory content but also an opportunity for additional tuition in Maths, English and Science, Vocational (coursework subjects) and General revision using strategies from tutor



PPE Masterclasses / Raise a Grade Days across key subject areas to support students and to stretch students to reach top grades (7-9). **Flexible teaching groups** - change classes to support their needs.



Drop Down Days (coursework completion in line with vocational deadlines)



Small group work in lessons / teacher assessment and feedback / bespoke interventions / 1:1 support



Revision Breakfast Club in the LRC (8-8:30am) everyday & Homework Club C1 P7 revision offer (fortnightly timetable)
