Next week marks the start of the KS3 assessment period for students in Year 7, Year 8 and Year 9. All students will complete an assessment in the subjects they have studied this year during this four-week window.

Assessments will be timetabled during normal lesson times, a link to the assessment timetable can be accessed here: KS3 End of Year assessment timetable

Assessments are produced centrally by the trust and students complete the same subject assessments as the other academies in the federation. If students normally receive support in lessons, then they will receive support during the assessment.

Assessments will then be marked by the teacher and the scores will help generate two types of data, a percentage score and a DOOYA grade. Both types of data will then be shared with you later in Term 6 as part of the end of year academic report.
