<b>Year 10</b>	<b>Thematic study: Crime and Punishment through time (c1000-present).</b>  An investigation into how the nature of crime and punishment has changed over time, from the Middle Ages through to the 20 <sup>th</sup> Century.		<b>Whitechapel, c1870-c1900, policing and the inner city</b>  This unit focuses on crime and policing in 19 <sup>th</sup> century Whitechapel including an investigation into the Jack the Ripper murders.	<b>British Depth Study: Early Elizabethan England (1558-88).</b>  A study into Elizabeth's relationship with government, the challenges she faced both home and abroad, and Elizabethan society.		<b>Modern Depth Study: Weimar and Nazi Germany (1918-39).</b>
<b>Year 11</b>	<b>Modern Depth Study: Weimar and Nazi Germany (1918-39).</b>  An investigation into Germany's democratic experiment during the years of the Weimar Republic, the reasons behind Hitler's rise to power, and what life was like in Nazi Germany up to 1939 and the eve of war.		<b>Non-British Depth study: Superpower relations and the Cold War, 1941-91</b>  A study into relations between the democratic West and Communist Russia in the years following WWII and up to the collapse of the USSR.		<b>Revision</b>	<b>GCSE Exams</b>
