What is The CMJT Scholarship?

- A small pot of money to help Year 11 students with their next steps in Post 16
- Students can apply to receive help up to the value of £200
- Selection process based on best applications, chosen by Academy Councillors/panel
- 5 students will be awarded the fund.

What could the money be used for?

Some Previous Examples:



- Chefs Whites/Knives
- Hair & Beauty Kit (Make Up Brushes, Hairdressing Scissors)
- Construction (Health & Safety Course, CSCS Card, Tools)
- Educational Trip
- Theatre Trip for those doing Performing Arts/Music/Drama/Dance
- Specific Uniform or Equipment
- Sports Kit/ Sports Sponsorship (e.g Team GB Gymnastics)
- A museum or gallery visit
