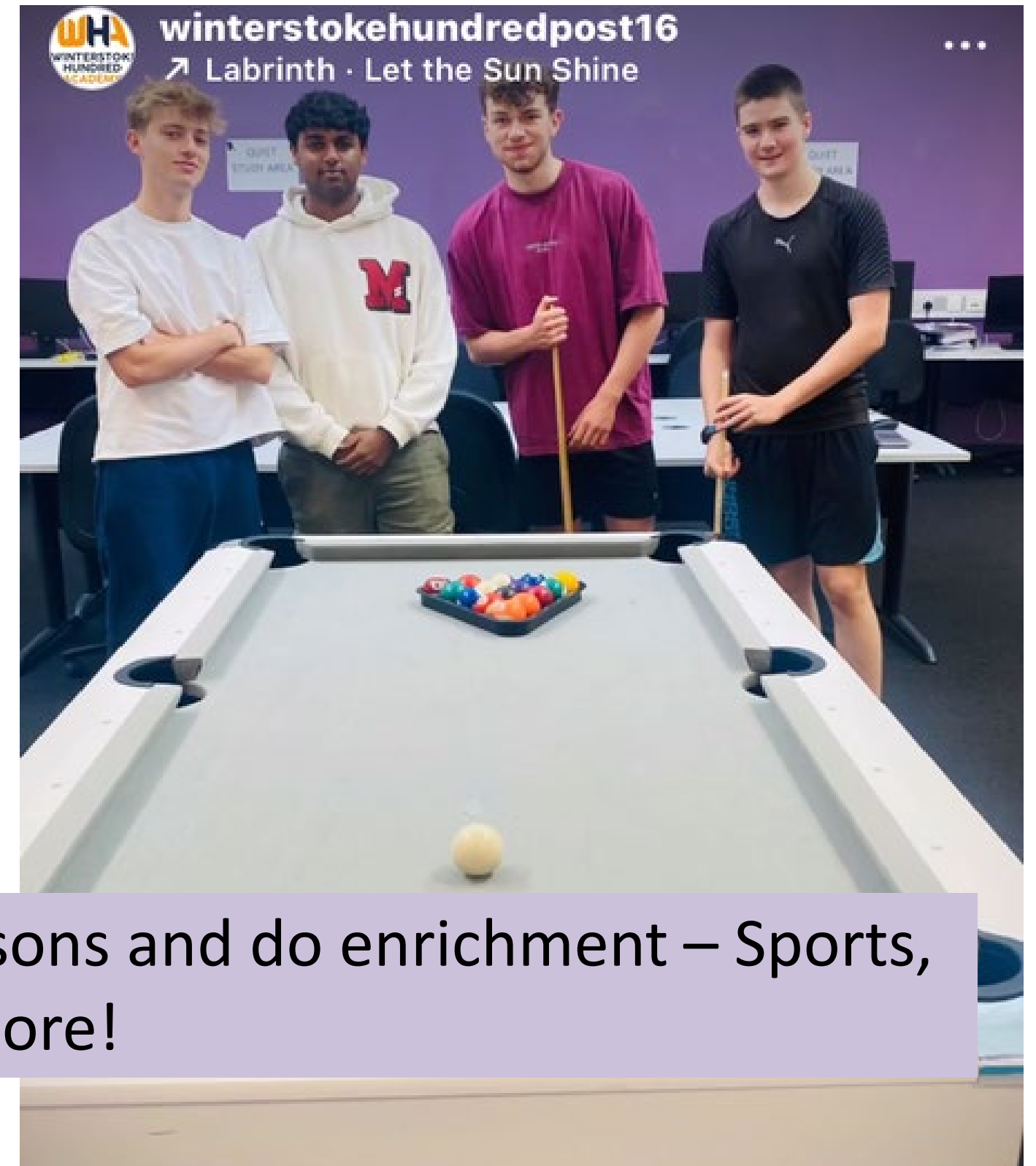

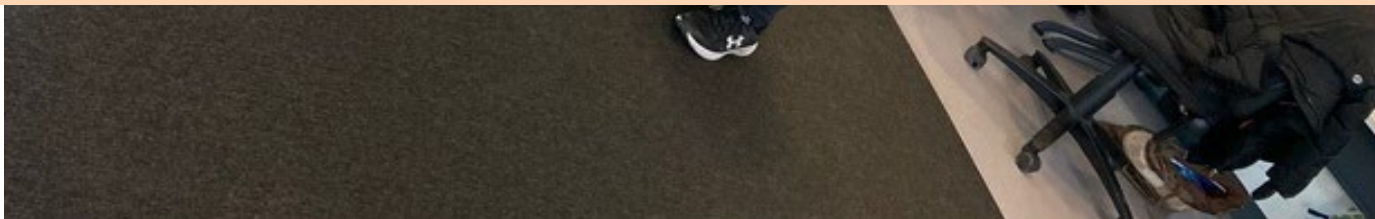


Enrichment – Every Wednesday afternoon we have no lessons and do enrichment – Sports, school newspaper, crochet, cooking, film club and loads more!
