- Attendance and engagement to tutor time really matters.






# Attendance & Belonging

- Additional Support for the student and family where there are concerns with attendance




# Reading

- Access a range of different literary texts across the year




### Reading and Exam Strategies

- Focus on reading to boost student's grades in all subjects!
- Students will look at techniques and exam strategies to access a range of texts across their different GCSE subjects.
- Set texts for GCSE English Literature are in focus and chances to revise quotations for these texts
