

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

Year 11 students are expected to attend at least 1 period 7 session per week between September and November; this increases to 2/3 after PPEs

Morning Tutorials

- Morning Tutorials take place every morning from 8:45-9:05am.
- During tutorials, tutors lead specific sessions (as seen on the example) alongside a weekly house assembly led by the HOH.
- Our tutor programmes are designed with the year group in mind
 - tailor-made to the needs of the year and key stage (KS3/KS4)

Y11 Morning Tutorials


- Y11 tutor programme has been designed to support students with wider skills needed to be successful at the end of Y11.

Attendance Diamond




Reading

- Sessions designed specifically for KS4 examination requirements.
- Develop good reading habits and support student's reading ability.
- Revision of key texts for English Literature (An Inspector Calls; Macbeth; Poetry and A Christmas Carol)



Reading and Exam Strategies

- Students will look at techniques and exam strategies to access a range of texts across their different GCSE subjects.
- Learning to read with speed during exam conditions.
- Learning to use access arrangements such as reading pens, reading rulers and overlays.



Wellbeing and Resilience

- Students to develop strategies to support their wellbeing
- Developing their critical thinking skills and how to apply these skills
- Managing stress
- Managing exams





Careers Advice and Guidance

What can you expect in Year 11?

- Various FE providers coming in delivering informative assemblies
- FE provider lunch time drop ins weekly
- Personal 1:1 Careers appointment with Level 6 IAG professional
- Year-round support from myself through whole process, application, interviews, accepting offers, searching for apprenticeships etc
- Designated Careers office with resources and support
- Bespoke 'Prospectus Pack' coming mid-October
- Presence at Parent Evenings so parents can have their questions/worries answered
- Mock interviews with real employers to build interview skills
- Updates and bulletins about Open Evenings, Half Term Workshops and other opportunities
