
### Y11 Morning Tutorials


## Attendance & Belonging

- Additional Support for the student and family where there are concerns with attendance.




### Reading

## Reading and Exam Strategies


- Students will look at techniques and exam strategies to access a range of texts across their different GCSE subjects.
